Cubmaster

Not as difficult as you may think. It is actually easier than being a Den Leader.

Put together the agenda for the monthly Pack meeting – about 30 minutes prep time a month

Attend a monthly Pack committee meeting – about 70 to 90 minutes a month

Attend monthly roundtable meeting or ensure that someone attends on behalf of the pack. You do not have to attend every roundtable. – 7:30 to 8:45 at the Glen Landing School

Signatory on the Pack checking account

Assist the Committee Chair (Kimberly) in the formation of committees for events and delegate responsibilities as needed

- Fall and Spring camp outs
- Winter overnigher
- Pinewood Derby
- Blue and Gold

This position will take about five to seven hours per month.

Treasurer

The Pack checking account requires two signature, you are not solely responsible. There are a total of five signatories, of which any two must sign checks.

Maintaining the checking account

Provide monthly account balance – print online statement and bring to committee meeting

Make deposits as needed

Write checks as needed – perhaps thirty checks a year

This position will take about two hours of your time per month.

Awards

Den leaders send you what the boys in their den earned every other month. You order the awards from council. Place the awards in zip lock bags for presentation at pack meetings. Awards are given every other month.

This position will take about three hours of your time every other month

Pack Apparel

At each pack meeting bring out the Pack t shirts and sweatshirts from the garage and make them available for sale to the pack. At the end of the meeting put them away. Maintain an inventory and order new product as necessary.

This position takes about one hour a month.
